The Wildlife Habitat Council has partnered with different organizations to create awards for outstanding wetland, prairie, pollinator and wild turkey management. Certified programs can submit applications for these awards annually, and the \$100 application fee is waived if the partner award application is submitted with a *Wildlife at Work*SM or *Corporate Lands for Learning*SM application.



Pollinator Protection Award

In partnership with North American Pollinator Protection Campaign (NAPPC), the Wildlife Habitat Council developed Pollinator Friendly Practice Guidelines and became the first organization to promote these guidelines. The Pollinator Protection Award recognizes companies that implement land management practices to promote and conserve pollinator populations.

Prairies for Tomorrow Award

This Prairies for Tomorrow Award is awarded by Pheasants Forever and the Wildlife Habitat Council in recognition of high quality programs that restore and manage upland or prairie habitat, which are important habitat for a diversity of wildlife species including pheasants and quail.



Wild Turkey Management Award

The Wild Turkey Management Award is awarded by the National Wild Turkey Federation (NWTf) and the Wildlife Habitat Council in recognition of a high quality management of wild turkeys and wild turkey habitat.
